

Court Order Statement

Mill Park Rebelz take player and member comfort and happiness very seriously. All attempts to maintain this will be made or considered by the Committee.

However there are various areas where we cannot accept responsibility.

Where court orders such as apprehended violence orders or restraining orders are in place for members of our club the Committee will *attempt* to assist in the adherence to such orders where possible. This may involve placing players in separate teams.

However, the Club does not have actual responsibility unless actually named as a subject of such an order. The responsibility for adherence to these orders lies with the individuals/parties to which the orders apply.

If placement of players in different teams may cause detriment or severe difficulty to other teams or members of the Club, this will not be arranged. Parents/players will have to make their own arrangements for adherence to relevant orders.

Coaches and Team Managers and the Committee are likewise not expected to be aware of or responsible for custody orders. Where a junior player is being released from a game or training session, it is the parent(s)'/guardian(s)' responsibility to be aware of who should or should not be collecting the player. Coaches/Team managers will not be held in loco parentis once the training session or game ends.
